

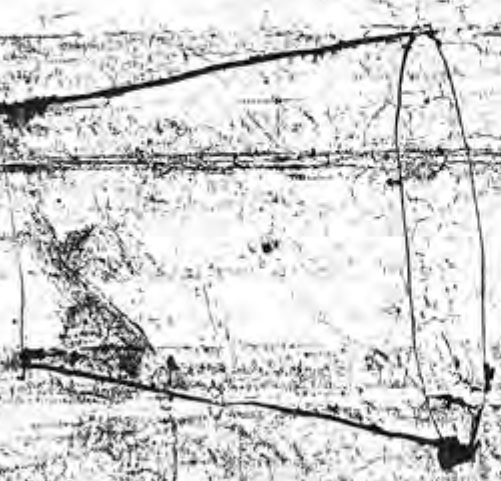

Specifications for lighting the street lamps in
the Town of Hottam for one year.

The contractor to light and extinguish the whole of the lamps in the Town (200) in number every night, with the exception of five nights in each lunar month, that is to say, two nights before full moon, and two nights after full moon, and the night of full moon.

2 The contractor must have the whole of the lamps lighted every night (except on the nights specified in the foregoing clause) within an hour after sunset, but he must not commence to light before sunset, and all lamps extinguished half an hour before sunrise each morning, or at such other hours as he may be from time to time directed.

3 The contractor will also be required to provide kerosene for those lamps in the Town for which gas is not connected. viz. one in Hardwicke St. - three in Buncle St. - two in Macaulay Road, and two in Boundary Road.

4 The contractor will be held responsible for the lamps continuing lighted during the time specified for lighting and extinguishing.

5 The contractor must keep all the glass in the lanterns well washed and perfectly clean, and must replace all broken or cracked glass, within twenty-four hours of its being so broken or cracked.

6 The contractor must at once report in writing any defect in the burners at metered lamps, meters, or meter boxes, or any leakage of gas to the Town Surveyor.

The burners when lighted of the lamps at which meter are attached to be regulated at the meter, and when exting^uished to be turned off at the meter, and care must be taken to perfectly lock the meter box.

8 The contractor must provide the necessary labor, ladders, matches, glass &c. and all other materials required for the proper carrying out of this contract.

9 The lamps must be lighted and exting^uished in regular order so that the fair average consumption of gas may be ascertained from the metered lamps. ~~such order of lighting and exting^uishing to be reported upon in writing.~~

10. Payments will be made at the first meeting of the council after the expiring of each calendar month, for the month previous when all fines (if any) incurred by the contractor will be deducted from the amount ~~it is due to him~~.

11 The council reserve power to cancel this contract at any time on giving fourteen days notice to the contractor, and if any new lamps are erected during the currency of this contract, the contractor will be ~~required~~ to light and exting^uish them at the same rate, and under the same conditions, as he ~~contracts~~ to light those above specified.

Fines to which the Contractor will be liable for neglecting to light or extinguish lamps, or for not keeping it lighted or extinguished in accordance with this specification or directions as herein provided, two shillings & sixpence.

For every lantern in dirty condition sixpence.

For allowing any broken parts to remain in a lantern for each twenty four hours each lantern } Sixpence

For neglecting to report any defect in burners at the ten meter stations, or meters, meter boxes, or escapes of gas, each case two shillings & sixpence.

A deposit of Five pounds will be required from the Contractor as a guarantee for the due performance of his contract, which deposit will be forfeited and become absolutely the property of the Council in the event of the conditions of the contract being broken or unfulfilled.

Tenders to state in their Tenders the rate per lamp per week at which they are prepared to carry out this contract.
